Childcare Screening Guidance for COVID-19

For each employee, parent, child or visitor:

- Take a temperature and log all temperatures greater than 100.4 degrees.
- Ask the screening questions below at entrance to facility:
 - Have you had any of these symptoms in the last 14 days?**
 - Fever greater than 100.4 degrees
 - Cough
 - Difficulty breathing
- Ensure that employees, parents, visitors or children are not allowed to enter the childcare center if they have experienced any of these symptoms within the last 14 days and have them call their healthcare provider.
- If a child or employee becomes ill during the day with these symptoms, send them home immediately and have them call their primary healthcare provider.
- Sick children should be separated until they are able to be picked up. Staff who are ill should go home immediately. Disinfect all areas where potentially ill individuals were.
